As you prepare your class for this outdoor school experience, please note the following:

- Cost is \$85/person per night; this includes adult chaperones. No charge for classroom teacher. \$80/person per night if full amount for the class is paid three months in advance.
- Each class is responsible for arranging transportation to and from the Camp Greider.

- Please plan to arrive no later than 10:30 am on the first day.
- Teachers and/or chaperones are responsible for the supervision and discipline of all students at all times, including overnight hours. Chaperones must remain with the students overnight.
- Instruct your students to dress appropriately for their outdoor school experiences. Refer to the packing list for recommended clothing and footwear.
